Special Provisions	SP117	<u>Subject to these Regulations only when transported by sea.</u>
	A199 (IATA DGR 66th edition)	<u>The UN number UN 3496 is only applicable in sea transport.</u> Nickel-metal hydride batteries or nickel-metal hydride battery-powered devices, equipment or vehicles having the potential of a dangerous evolution of heat are not subject to these Regulations provided they are prepared for transport so as to prevent: (a) a short circuit (e.g. in the case of batteries, by the effective insulation of exposed terminals; or, in the case of equipment, by disconnection of the battery and protection of exposed terminals); and (b) unintentional activation.

Verdict and Instructions	YAMAHA Nickel Metal Hydride Battery (JWB2) is applicable to the above Special Provisions. Therefore, the battery is not restricted in air transport and transportable by aircraft.
	Follow the instructions below to prevent a short circuit and unintentional activation: The battery must be removed from the vehicle. The battery must be protected from short circuit by insulating the terminals (e.g. by protective cap). The removed battery must be protected from damage for example by placing each battery in a protective pouch.  Final instructions are subject to airline companies with reference to this document.
